Learning Lodge Academy Dress Code Reminders

Dry fit shirts & polos can **ONLY** be purchased through **360 Custom Ink**. Find the link to order uniforms on the Parent Info Page of LLA's website.

****NEW sweatshirts & sweater options coming soon!**

Uniforms that are faded, stained, tattered or torn are considered dress code violations.

Garment	Monday – Thursday	Friday***
Tops	Dry fit shirt with LLA logo* Polo with logo* Sweatshirts or sweaters with LLA logo*	School appropriate t-shirts.** (NO halter tops, spaghetti strap shirts, tank tops, sleeveless shirts, crop tops, or low cut tops are allowed.)
Bottoms	Khaki or Navy: Pants, shorts, skirts, or jumpers (fingertip length), or leggings. (NO jeans)	Pants, shorts, skirts, jumpers, or dresses (fingertip length). (NO jeans with rips above the knee)
Shoes	Closed-toe shoes (NO sandals or flip flops)	Closed-toe shoes (NO sandals or flip flops)
Accessories	NO hats, hoods, or head covering (indoors), dangling earrings, make-up, or distracting hair color/styles	NO hats, hoods, or head covering (indoors), dangling earrings, make-up, or distracting hair color/styles

The Principal, or designee, will have the final authority on what is “school appropriate.”

Common Violations

*Jeans, sweatpants, yoga pants should **NOT** be worn Monday-Thursday.

*If your child needs a sweatshirt or sweater to wear during the school day, it **MUST** have the LLA Logo on it.

Consequences for Dress Code Violations

1st Violation ~ Warning to student & parents contacted with a reminder of dress code

2nd Violation ~ Parents contacted to bring in uniform (students wait in office)

3rd Violation ~ Detention

4th Violation ~ In-School Suspension
